M175/15 Manea Cemetery - drainage works

Further to minute M166/15, the Chairman reminded members of the flooding being caused to the gardens of neighbouring properties as a result of issues with the drainage system at Manea Cemetery; he detailed the current deficiencies within that drainage system, caused by blockages at certain points, and the associated consequences for nearby land.

The Chairman informed members that some remedial works had been undertaken to alleviate the problem and that, as a result, water now seems to be flowing freely through the drainage system. He suggested to members that there would be benefit in undertaking further investigation of the condition of the drainage system and also clearance works to the manholes at the cemetery.

Members decided, unanimously, that

- (1) the current situation be noted;
- (2) further investigation of the condition of the drainage system, through the use of appropriate cameras, be undertaken and that this matter be considered further by the council in the light of the results of the investigation;
- (3) clearance works to the manholes at the cemetery be undertaken.
